- 1 metre or 3 foot wide path from each room to every exit
- Flammable items 1 metre away from furnace/ hot water heater/hydro panels
- Incorrect storage of flammable liquid
- Blocked exits and stairwells
- Electrical hazards
- Working smoke alarms
- Large quantity of flammable items present
